

STATEMENT OF CONDUCT

1. Since “it is enough for the student to be like his teacher, and the servant like his Master” (Matthew 10:25) and that children learn appropriate behavior through modeling the “significant others” in their lives, it is essential that staff members model a Godly character in all facets of their lives.
2. Since certain types of actions and behaviors are deemed inconsistent with the disciple-making process taught at The Master’s Academy, teachers must:
 - Avoid a sexually immoral lifestyle, including “living with” a member of the opposite sex or engaging in homosexual relationships. I Corinthians 6:18; I Thessalonians 4:3
 - Refrain from television, movies and music or other media which emphasize immorality, the drug culture, or rebellion against authority. Romans 16:19; Colossians 3:1,2
 - Avoid the appearance of evil. I Thessalonians 5:22
 - Wear modest apparel. I Timothy 2:9
 - Abstain from gossip, grumbling and complaining. Philippians 2:14; Proverbs 26:20
 - Abstain from the use of or possession of alcoholic drinks, tobacco or drugs. I Corinthians 6:19, 20
 - Not be convicted of a felony or morally reprehensible misdemeanor.
3. Christian fellowship is essential for spiritual growth. Each staff member will be regularly attending a local, evangelical, Bible-believing church.

If hired, I will live in accordance with these stipulations except for the differences explained below.
