At the very least, television station WFTV Channel 9 and radio stations WDBO 580 AM, WTLN 950 AM, and Z88.3 FM will be our direct communication channels. If our phone system is working, plans will be communicated via a phone message to your home. We will also use e-mail if our system allows. In addition, we'll update our school's answering machine with pertinent information. (407) 971-2221.

TMA will follow the **first day** closing decisions made by the Seminole County School System. So if you hear that Seminole County Schools is closed...that initial day, TMA is right there with them. Re-opening, however, will be determined at the discretion of the TMA administration. Often times, TMA is able to assess the situation on our campus and we find we're able to open earlier than the Seminole County School System.
